

1 DISC BRAKES

For safe, sure stops and sensitive control, the GSX750E carries the latest in perforated disc brakes — dual on the front and single on the rear. In combination with the fivestar cast wheels of Suzuki's original design, you're assured of optimum performance and optimum handling whatever the road conditions.

2 METERS

On the large, newly designed meter panel, each meter and indicator is carefully placed to keep you fully informed at a glance with the minimum necessary eye motion. At night, the meters are illuminated with a gentle orange light for easy visibility.

(3) LAMPS

The lamps feature an elegantly sporty and highly individual rectangular design. For brighter illumination and longer life, the large head lamp uses a 60 Watt/55 Watt sealed-beam halogen lamp. The turn signals and tail lamp have also been designed for greater visibility and therefore greater safety in traffic.

The turn signal switch (featuring a convenient auto canceller), horn button, passing switch and dimmer switch are clustered on the left handlebar, while engine stop switch and lighting switch are on the right carefully arranged for the maximum ease and accuracy of use.
